Conducted under the auspices of the Military Order of the World Wars, approved by the National Association of Secondary School Principals and affiliated the National Sojourners, Inc, HOBY (Hugh O'Brien Youth Foundation), and the Joe Foss Institute for Leadership.

Our 4-day program costs only \$300 per student which covers booklets, notebook, T-shirt, bed and food, guided tours of three (3) historic sites, instruction by paid and volunteer professionals. It does not include transportation to-from and any memento purchases at the historic tour sites.

The **American Independence YLC** belongs to a not-for-profit 501(c)(19) Hampton Roads Military Order of the World Wars organization operated by dedicated veterans offering an outstanding, nationally respected, 4-day Youth Leadership Conference (YLC) in the Jamestown-Williamsburg-Yorktown area of Virginia for up to 45 selected high school juniors and sophomores. Founded in April 2002, our upcoming **May 2 to May 5, 2018** YLC will be our 20th, and our students have consistently rated us 3.5 or better on a 4-point scale. Over our 16 years, about 10% of our 800 students traveled from **CA, CT, FL, IL, KY, LA, MD, MO, NC, NH, NJ, NM, NY, OK, OR, PA, SC, TX, UT, WI**.

★ We desire both JROTC and non-JROTC students in our classes. Home-schooled are very welcome too. Therefore, we respectfully ask the JROTC leaders receiving this flyer to please forward it to their school's guidance counselors so that others may learn about and participate with us – **we generally try to limit participation to 2 JROTC and 2 non-JROTC students per high school.**

Onsite registration begins at 3 p.m., Thursday, May 2, 2019, and the conference ends at 2:00 p.m., Sunday, May 5, 2019. Parents are invited to observe anytime, **but especially at 1 PM Sunday for the closing ceremony.**
